


cahoot is the name for Clearwater Bay School's **Virtual Learning Environment (VLE)** which is an online area designed to support learning at home and at school. It is powered by two different pieces of software: *Moodle* and *Google Apps for Education*.

The short web address for cahoot is gg.gg/cahoot

In order to access Cahoot, students *must* sign in using their Cahoot username and password. The individual username and password can be found inside the student diary. Parents should use their child's username and password to access Cahoot.


The username and password follow this format:

Username:	chanj2
Password:	james423/



Children should be encourage to keep their username and password private. If your child forgets their password, please send a note in the diary to their class teacher. We will then be able to reset the password.

Google Apps for Education is another part of our VLE and is linked to Cahoot. Google Apps allows students to create documents, graphics, maps and presentations, collaborate with others and join together with their class in Google Classroom. Student portfolios are also created and managed within Google Sites.



Students usually access their Google Apps account by logging into Cahoot and clicking the Google Drive icon, however they *can* log into Google directly by adding @student.cwbs.edu.hk to their Cahoot username.

Again, parents should log into their child's Google Drive account using their child's password.
